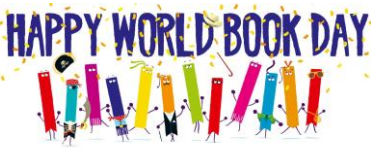


SPRING TERM - Friday 12th March
