*If you are able to the teachers would appreciate it if you could return completed work on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February as usual so they can mark and assess during the half term.*

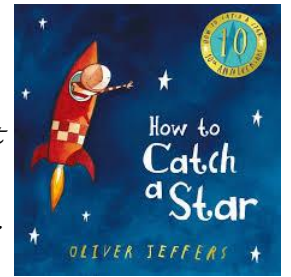
